Role profile:

Supporting smooth running of the Airport by providing manual handling and logistics services across a range of projects.

Responsible for maintaining high standards regarding health and safety and security.

Liaises with Customers and Operational Management Teams across the Airport.

Duties:

- Loading and unloading passenger bags within the system.
- Operating vehicles, assets and manual handling devices.
- Reading baggage tags to ensure bags are in correct location.
- Overseeing inputs and outputs in line with project objectives.
- Carrying out role in accordance to risk assessment, method statements and training received.
- Checking timesheets and paperwork are correctly completed and signed off by relevant managers daily.
- Conducting daily checks on vehicles and other assets, flagging issues and risks to management.
- Data entry onto system surveys and shift reports.
- Liaise closely with the Operations Management Team regarding any issues and requirements.
- Liaise with Customers on performance of baggage system.
- Safely driving company vehicles as required (If applicable).

- Excellent communication skills.
- Capable of repeated heavy lifting.
- Ability to work under pressure and as part of a team.
